RETINAL AND OPTIC NERVE PHOTOGRAPHY

These digital pictures of the back of your eyes not only assist in the early detection of retinal disease, optic nerve disease, melanoma of the eye but also begin to tell a story from one year to the next allowing our doctors to detect subtle changes that are much more accurate than chart notes. Many diseases of the body including diabetes, high blood pressure, inflammatory diseases and neurological diseases affect the inside of the eye and may be detected earlier with retinal photography.

EARLY DETECTION OF GLAUCOMA

Glaucoma causes gradual and in most cases painless blindness. It's often referred to as the silent thief of sight. It is the result of damage and thinning of the optic nerve fibers. It can damage your vision so gradually you don't notice any loss of vision until the disease is at an advanced stage.

With our new Advanced OCT (**O**cular **C**oherence **T**omography) imaging technology we are able to detect glaucoma sooner thus preventing loss of sight. Our doctor's are Optometric Glaucoma Specialists and highly recommend this test for anyone over the age of 18.

EARLY DETECTION OF MACULAR DEGENERATION

Macular degeneration is a progressive degenerative eye disease of the central retina that often times goes undetected. It is the leading cause of central vision loss. There are many causes for macular degeneration including genetics, poor diet, smoking and excessive exposure to ultra violet light. Once macular degeneration begins to decrease your best corrected vision it becomes difficult to treat but with early detection there are many treatment plans that can reduce its progress and prevent blindness.

This screening is diagnostic for anyone 18 years of age or older, anyone who has a close family member with macular generation or anyone who has ever used tobacco products in the past.
