## Why is the contact lens examination separate from the comprehensive eye examination fee?

Insurance companies require doctors to separate routine eye examination fees from contact lens fees. Most insurance companies treat contact lenses as **cosmetic and optional**, and therefore do not cover any fees associated with them. Fees are required because the staff and doctors perform additional tests and spend more time with patients who wear contact lenses.

Contact lenses are medical devices that can only be dispensed with a doctor's prescription. They are regarded with the same caution as prescription drugs and must include size, shape, type, replacement schedules, expiration dates and required follow-up visits.

Contact Lens Evaluation 2 (within 13 months of last exam and prescription changes):	\$49.00

## **Contact Lens Fittings (For patients who are new to contacts or must be completely refit):**

Contact lens examinations and fittings have different levels of difficulty; this depends on the type of contact lenses needed, the visual requirement of the patient, and the health of the patient's eyes.
