## *Contact Lens Services and Fees*

If you are having a complete eye examination, and you are a contact lens wearer, the doctor needs to perform additional tests. The doctor must confirm the contact lenses fit properly and pose no risk to the health of the eyes. We want to assure your contact lenses are providing your eyes the best comfort, vision and health possible.

The fee for a contact lens service is based on the amount of time necessary and the difficulty involved. The type of evaluation necessary will be determined by the doctor and will be discussed before proceeding with the contact lens service. In some instances, insurance companies will not cover contact lens services.

### **Contact Lens Examination                    \$60**

This is for any patient currently wearing contact lenses, without problems, who want their contact lens prescription updated **during a routine eye examination**. It is best for the patient to wear their contact lenses to their examination appointment. New patients will need to provide either a copy of their previous contact lens prescription or packaging from their most recent contact lenses. The doctor will first confirm the contact lenses fit properly and pose no threat to the health of the eyes, and then update the contact lens prescription with any necessary power changes. If a contact lens examination is declined during the routine exam, a **separate evaluation visit** (see below) will be necessary to update the contact lens prescription at a later date.

### **Contact Lens Evaluation                    \$95**

This is for any patient currently wearing contact lenses but experiencing problems with vision or comfort, which may necessitate a change of contact lens type. The doctor will try new contact lenses and evaluate the lens fit, clarity of vision and lens power. The evaluation may be performed either during a routine eye examination or during an independent 30-minute office visit.

### **Contact Lens Fitting or Refit**

Today there are more choices in contact lenses and care than ever before. During your fitting appointments, the doctor will determine the contact lenses that provide the best vision, comfort and eye health for you. A fitting includes six months of unlimited follow-up care. Because of patients' differing visual requirements, potential dry eyes and other individual factors, it is impossible to predict which patients will achieve success with contact lens wear. Although we do everything possible to assure patients achieve clear and comfortable vision with contact lenses, as the fees are for the doctor's time, full refunds for unsuccessful candidates are not possible. If a patient discontinues the fitting, after the six month period they will be charged for any additional contact lens services.
